



INVITATION TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

Dear Paneuropean friends,

It is our pleasure and honor to invite you to the Paneuropean International Conference *"Bosnia and Herzegovina between Dayton and Brussels: From Dayton Agreement to the Stabilization and Association Agreement"* that will be held in Mostar on September 11 – 13, 2015.

The Conference is scheduled to start on Friday, September 11th at 6:00 PM in the newly reconstructed City Hall.

As always, we expect a great number of respectable guests and speakers.

Paneuropean Union of B&H will cover the accommodation costs for two members of each Paneuropean organization and we hope that we will be able to cover the accommodation costs for at least two representatives of youth sections.

The accommodation will be organized in the new hotel "Mostar", in the downtown of Mostar (www.hotelmostar.ba) in the vicinity of the City Hall, 5 minutes by walk, and for youth in the Student Hotel Mostar (www.studenthotel.ba) that is 15 minutes by walk from the City Hall.

The accommodation price is very affordable. In the "Mostar" hotel our guests enjoy a special discount, 35 € for the single room and 53 € for the double room. In the Student Hotel Mostar price of the single room is 23 €, 35 € is the price for the double room and 46 € for the triple room.

Official languages, apart from the national languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina, will also include English language with simultaneous translation.

Participation fee is 20 € and for the representatives of the youth section it's free.

For those who travel by plane, we suggest to book a flight to Sarajevo or, if the flight to Split is significantly cheaper, book your ticket to Split. We will arrange the transportation from and to the designated airports.

Attached to this e-mail is the Application form; we kindly ask you to fill it and send it back to us no later than July 20, 2015.

We are always available to you for any additional information.

In the hope that you will take part in our Conference, which carries a great significance for our country, we send you our cordial greetings.
