RESOLUTION

The General Assembly of the International Pan-European Union,

- gathered in the European Parliament in Strasbourg a few days after the 80th anniversary of the Yalta Conference,
- outraged by attempts by Russia and the USA to once again decide the fate of deeply European states such as Ukraine, the Kingdom of Denmark, and the countries of the Western Balkans over the heads of continental Europeans,
- alarmed by the efforts of nationalist parties and governments, still trapped in nationalist thinking, to block the rapid further integration of the European Union in the field of common foreign and defence policy or to postpone it to a distant future,

calls for:

- 1. further development of the EU, or at least those of its Member States that are prepared to do so, into a genuine political power in close cooperation with the European institutions.
- 2. the swift establishment of a European defence community with a common army in addition to strong, networked national armed forces,
- 3. uniting behind the European Commissioner for Foreign Affairs, Kaja Kallas, and the first Commissioner for Defence in history, Andrius Kubilius, two very competent Baltic Pan-Europeans,
- 4. the building up of a defence industry that is independent of the USA, especially in terms of technology,
- 5. the acceleration of the enlargement policy in Eastern Europe and the Western Balkans,
- 6. vigorous efforts, by all peaceful means, to prevent a betrayal of the invaded Ukrainian people, to enable Ukraine to join the EU and NATO, to provide it with the necessary weapons, including ammunition, and to massively increase humanitarian aid for Ukraine to compensate for the loss of US aid,
- 7. the immediate cessation of the Putin regime's attempts to bring Europe under its rule, piece by piece.
